

Form 5. **Fellowship**

Criteria

Fellowship status will be available to

a) Accredited Independent Practitioners who

- i) have a minimum of 10 years experience in GI Physiology and
- ii) have taken an active role in the Association and
- iii) are considered, by the Council, to have made an outstanding contribution to GI Physiology.

b) Affiliated Members with no clinical experience who

- i) fulfill the criteria for fellowship as above
- ii) have been employed in academic research or development or teaching

Those members who have attained the status of Fellows would be recognised as having the appropriate experience to give expert advice in their field of practice.

Such individuals must be proposed by two Fellows of AGIP, scrutinised by the Accreditation Committee and ratified by the full Council. Fellows may use the designatory letters FAGIP.

Guidance notes

Once an application has been received by the Accreditation and Education Committee, the chair will request a short personal profile from the candidate in support of the nomination and appoint two senior members of the Association to scrutinise the application and forward a recommendation to the full AGIP Council using Form 5. (this form is for internal use only)
